SUMMARY

Buildings are among our largest sources of climate pollution, and they need to become 21st century models of efficiency and sustainability. That work begins with the decisions made by our business owners. The City of Los Angeles Green Business Program helps make our businesses more sustainable by offering free green consulting, referrals to City rebate programs, networking opportunities, and marketing perks. Through this program, as well as through collaborations with Neighborhood Council Sustainability Alliance (NCSA) and neighborhood councils, the City hopes to certify 1,000 businesses "as Green Businesses" by 2025.

<u>Certified "Green Businesses" in California had the</u> <u>following impacts in 2019:</u>

- \$18 million saved in utility bills
- 99,000 metric tons of solid waste diverted from landfills -- equivalent to 3,780 garbage trucks worth of diverted waste
- 742 million gallons of water saved
- 422,000 metric tons of greenhouse gas emission saved — equivalent to planting 427,262 acres of trees

Sample green practices that businesses can choose to take from a checklist in order to be certified include:

- Reduce Water Use: Low-flow toilets and faucets
- <u>Conserve Energy</u> with energy-efficient lighting and equipment
- <u>Commute Sustainably</u> by promoting and incentivizing alternative modes of transportation for employees
- <u>Prevent Pollution</u> by eliminating and/or properly disposing of harmful chemicals
- <u>Use Non-Toxic Cleaners</u> with safer, environmentally-friendly cleaning products
- <u>Avoid Waste</u> by eliminating unnecessary packaging, printing, and purchasing
- <u>Recycle Materials</u> to divert waste from landfills through reuse, recycling, and composting
